

## **ROYAL WOOTTON BASSETT TOWN COUNCIL**

### **STANDING CONDITIONS OF HIRE OF SHOWGROUNDS**

The applicant will be required to abide by the following conditions and notify the Council in writing prior to his visit that he is in agreement with such conditions:

1. A Public Liability Insurance is held to the value of at least £2m (two million pounds).
2. Complete indemnity is given to the Council in all aspects regarding the occupancy of the site.
3. No fly posting will be permitted unless the full permission of the owners/occupiers of properties has been obtained in writing.
4. All manure will be cleared from the site daily.
5. On completion of the visit the site is to be cleared of all rubbish and grass areas reinstated, or to pay to the Council the reasonable cost for carrying out this work.
6. All music, loudhailers etc to be turned down to a minimum and to be turned off by 2230 hours Monday to Friday and 2300 hours on Saturday.
7. No show will be permitted on Sundays, neither will the use of music or generators.
8. Drawing on and off of the Showground will take place during the hours of daylight with no work or movement whatsoever between the hours of midnight and 0700 hours. All activities will be carried out with the minimum of inconvenience to adjacent householders.
9. All equipment shall comply with the requirements laid down in "The Guide To Safety At Fairs". Access shall be afforded to the Council's Safety Officer to inspect certification.
10. It is agreed that the appropriate charge as applicable at the time of hiring shall be paid at least one week in advance of occupation of the site.
